Guidance notes

1. For residential and day conferences there is a fixed number of bursaries available. The limit is set at 5 per cent of the total number of estimated attendees.
2. Each bursary amounts to 50 per cent of the full price of the event, i.e., the non-discounted rate.
3. The monies needed are recouped through the appropriate pricing of the conference.
4. The criterion for granting a bursary is one of financial need, i.e., the person is on benefits/ low income/unemployed/student. Retirement *per se* is not a qualifier.
5. Applicants need not be a member of PCN Britain.
6. Two trustees decide on the merits of applications. If there is a high demand then those meriting a bursary will be considered on a first-come first-served basis.
7. No successful recipient of a bursary can apply for another within two years. However, the trustees may exercise their discretion in some circumstances, e.g., if the demand for conference bursaries is low.
8. Your application will be seen by Sarah Guilfoyle, who is the PCN Britain administrator, and by the two trustees responsible for allocating bursaries.
